A crumply rumply cowl, knit in cosy Wensleydale Aran, Altounyan is the perfect quick knit for a last minute gift.

Cast on 110 sts and join to begin working in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker.

You will now work 5 rounds in moss stitch for the edging.

Round 1 - (K1, P1) to end.

Round 2 - (P1, K1) to end.

Rounds 3 & 5 - As round 1

Round 4 - As round 2.

Work 11 rounds in stocking stitch (*K every stitch, every round*).

Round 17 - *{poke right needle tip through purl bump 11 rows below next stitch (at back of work) and place loop on left needle, knit loop together with next stitch} x3, K19, repeat from * to end.

Work 7 rounds straight in stocking stitch.

Round 24 - *{K11, poke right needle tip through purl bump 11 rows below next stitch (at back of work) and place loop on left needle, knit loop together with next stitch} x3, K8, rep from * to end.

Work 18 rounds straight in stocking stitch.

Repeat rounds 17 through 42 once more.

Repeat rounds 17 through 24 once more.

Repeat rounds 1 through 5 once more.

Bind off all stitches in moss stitch.



Yarn: 220 yards / 200 metres Aran.
(Sample shown in Hannalin Crafts Wensleydale Aran handspun).

Needles: 5mm 24" circular needle.

Gauge: 17 stitches and 22 rows per 4" in stocking stitch.

Abbreviations: K ~ Knit. P ~ Purl.
